Our Mission

The **St. John's Children Center** has been established to assist parents in meeting the God-given responsibility of guiding their children through various stages of growth and development to become independent, self-sufficient adults. The Center offers a loving, accepting Christian environment in which young children can develop to their fullest potential spiritually, physically, emotionally, socially, intellectually and creatively. Our Goals

1. To help establish themselves 'away from home.'
2. To help children learn to interact with their peers.
3. To utilize the rapid learning years of three and four years old to their greatest potential.

5. To establish the foundation for formal education by forming an early, close home-school relationship which can provide vital guidance in the primary grades.

8. To guide children to a better understanding and a more extensive relationship with Jesus Christ as their Savior.

Organization

Our Program

A good early childhood curriculum adopts self-directed learning as its objective. This method assumes that the most effective learning is that which grows out of the child's own motivation. With this type of curriculum, the St. John's Children Center teacher will:

1. provide the child with choices.
2. offer the child opportunities for experiencing and understanding their environment through manipulation, through play, through exploration of materials and ideas at the child's own rate, and
3. interact with the child to reinforce and extend his choices and discoveries.

To insure that our Center assists a child in growing to his or her potential, a very carefully planned and supervised program is presented to the child. We include various activities of play, religion, movement, math, science, music, social studies, language arts and creative arts.

St. John's Children Center is in harmony with the State Department of Social Services and is licensed under their authority and supervision.
